The Grower Agrees:

1. To pay full amount of the agreed total fee before the bees are delivered.
2. To avoid using pesticides known to be harmful to bees (especially neonicotinoids) in the crop/yard during the rental period.
3. To warn the beekeeper if neighbors use toxic sprays.
4. To provide uncontaminated water supply for the bees.
5. To assume liability for livestock damage or vandalism.
6. To assume public liability for stinging while the bees are on location in the crop.
7. To not enter or manipulate beehives unless with consent of Beekeeper.

The Beekeeper Agrees:

1. To leave the bees in the crop for a period necessary for effective pollination estimated to be approximately first part of May until first part of September.

2. To ensure that colonies are properly located and will remain in good condition while pollinating crop.
3. To check the beehives monthly, or sooner if a problem arises.
4. To give Grower 3 lbs (one quart) of honey per rented hive.
